## Regular Online Classes and Attendance

Hope that all of you have gone through the video lessons already posted in OLASH. In the initial days, there were some problem with the server and it is rectified now. School would like to start officially the online classes for Std X from 20-May-2020, Wednesday and the attendance will be counted from 20-May-2020. Schedule of the subjects is as follows:

Monday – English Tuesday – Malayalam / Hindi Wednesday – Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) Thursday – Social Science Friday – Mathematics Saturday – Test Papers / Self Study

Video lessons will be posted prior to the scheduled days and the respective teachers will give you the portions of each day through the School Digital and its assignments. Students must watch the video lesson in the morning itself, go through the notes and text and watch the video again if required. Subject teachers will be available online in google meet to clear your doubts. Schedule of the meeting will be given along with the portions of the day by the subject teachers. After clearing the doubts, students must submit the assignments on the same day itself. Delay in submission will result in reduction of 0.5 attendance per day. Students should write down the notes in your notebooks as per the instruction of the subject teacher.

As I told you in the google meeting, you are expected to spend 7-8 hours (5 hours in school and 2-3 hours at home) a day in study. In the initial days of online classes, portions could be less in quantity. It will be increased gradually.

During the online classes, if you are facing any technical issues, you can contact me (8089244387) either through text or WhatsApp message. You must mention your name and admission number in every communication.

A short video on how to upload your assignment is being prepared. Link of the video shall be shared to you by Wednesday. Even if lock-down is fully withdrawn and regular classes started, online classes will continue on Saturdays and other days of selected holidays. There is a general feeling that students are to be equipped with learning from online platform and online learning is going to play a big role in higher studies. This system will continue in Std 11 & 12.
