Rules for online competitions

- Students of LKG and UKG will be able to take part in the competition. Students of LKG can participate in the events from category I and students of UKG can take part in the events from category II.
- Judgment will be on the basis of criteria given for each item. There should not be any vulgarity or obscenity in actions, costumes or wordings. Judges decision will be final and the awards will be announced within a week from the last date for each event.

- Registration for online competitions will begin from 08 June, 2020. Each child can send only
 one video under each category. The starting date and the ending date of entry for each
 competition is given below. Late entries after the ending date for any event will not be
 considered for judgment.
- Parents should provide the participants' name, Admission number, class (LKG or UKG), and name of the competition with each entry.

Criteria for judgment:

- 1. Action Song-Malayalam (LKG & UKG), Time: 3 minutes
- Any action song can be selected.
- Performance without action will not be considered as action song.
- Props are strictly not allowed.

Criteria - Actions, Expression, pronunciation and clarity of words, rhythm

- 2. Action Song-English (LKG & UKG), Time: 3 minutes
- Any action song can be selected.
- Performance without action will not be considered as action song.
- Props are strictly not allowed

Criteria - Actions, Expression, pronunciation and clarity of words, rhythm.

- 3. Story telling-Malayalam (LKG & UKG), Time: 3 minutes
- Any story with a moral can be selected.

Criteria - Pronunciation, Fluency, expression, voice modulation, action

- 4. Story telling-English (LKG & UKG), Time: 3 minutes
- Any story with a moral can be selected.

Criteria - Pronunciation, Fluency, expression, voice modulation, action

- 5. Singing-English (UKG), Time: minimum 3 minutes
- Any English song other than nursery rhymes and action songs can be sung.

Criteria-Pronunciation, melody, rhythm & Clarity

- 6. Singing- Malayalam (LKG & UKG), Time: minimum 3 minutes
- Any Malayalam song from film/album (other than rhymes and action songs) can be sung.

Criteria - Pronunciation, melody, rhythm & Clarity

- 7. Elocution-English (UKG) Topic My Family; Time: 3 minutes
- 8. Elocution-Malayalam (UKG) Topic- 'Maram oru varam' Time: 3 minutes Criteria for Elocution – Content, fluency, pronunciation, presentation & voice modulation
- 9. Nadanpattu (UKG) Time limit: 3 to 5 minutes.
- Any Malayalam folk song other than film songs original or remixed version can be selected for 'naadan paattu'.
- Judgment will be based on the qualities like selection of song, tempo, rhythm, pronunciation, fluency and melody.

10. Single Dance (LKG & UKG), Time: 3 to 5 minutes

- There will be separate dance competitions for boys and girls.
- Dance should be based on Film Music from any Indian Language with appropriate costume.
 Make up shall be permitted.
- Decency and decorum shall be maintained in the dress and steps performed.
- Hand props are permitted if required.

Criteria – Costume, synchronization, choreography, overall presentation

Off- Stage Events

Off- Stage Events such as Pencil Drawing for UKG, Colouring with crayons, Clay modelling, Memory Game and origami for LKG and UKG will be conducted after the school reopening. Train your children for each event according to the details given below.

- 1. Colouring with crayons (LKG &UKG), Time: 1 hour
- An outline picture will be given.
- Crayons/Oil pastels can be used.

Criteria - Neatness, shading & composition, Color concept

- 2. Pencil Drawing (UKG), Time: 1 hour
- A4 sheet will be provided.
- Any picture can be drawn.

Criteria - Neatness, creativity, shading

3. Origami (Paper Folding – LKG & UKG), Time: 30 minutes

- Origami paper (size: 15cm x 15cm) will be provided.
- Participant can make only **one object** using any single coloured paper.
- Use of accessories are not allowed

Criteria - Neatness, creativity, number of folds.

4. Clay modelling (LKG &UKG) Time: 45 minutes

- Participant can make only one object using any two or three coloured clay (play dough)
- Participants should bring the clay from home according to the object they plan to make.
- Use of accessories or extra objects will not be permitted except a tooth pick for reinforced works.

Criteria - neatness, perfection, creativity, imagination, colour concept.

5. Memory Game (LKG &UKG) Time: 30 minutes

- Pictures/images will be projected on the Projector Screen for 1 minute.
- Participant will have to circle only the images shown.
- Participant who circles all the pictures with no errors will be declared the winner.
