- Portions of the subjects of the next day will be given to you through the messaging system of olash by 5 pm of the previous day. For example, suppose Subject 1 is English and Subject 2 is Mathematics on Wednesday. Then Portions for English and Mathematics will be published by previous day 5 pm, that is, Tuesday 5 pm.
- Google meet of Subject 1 will be on Wednesday at 3 pm and google meet of Subject 2 will be on next day at 8:30 am, that is Thursday at 8:30 am. Students will receive the link of the google meet 15 minutes before the scheduled time in olash. Students are requested to mute your audio and video as you join the meet. But, at the instruction of the teacher, you must unmute your audio and video. Teacher may ask one or more students to unmute either audio or video or both.
- Google meet of the second subject of Friday will be held on Saturday at 8:30 am.
- It is expected that students would have studied the given portions by going through the given videos and notes before the google meet. Google meet is to clear the doubts of the students and for the teachers to ask questions to make sure that students have studied the given portions.
- Students shall click on the link you received to join the google meet.
- Students must expect test papers as of regular classes. Details shall be given to you.
- Students must also expect mid term and term exams for Std 06-08 and PT1, PT2, PT3 and annual examination for Std 09 & 10. Details will be given.
- Since many students were not able to watch the videos, portions will be started fresh from Monday (06-July-2020) for Std 01-09.
- There could be minor changes in the timetable. If there is any change you will be informed.

Clarification on some more points

Can the videos be downloaded? – Downloading the video increases the load on server heavily. Therefore, as of now, there will not be downloading of the videos. Now, we are using a video player which is having unlimited bandwidth. Therefore, dragging of the video will not be there. Naturally, it will take sometime to start the video depending upon the internet connection you have.

Can we have WhatsApp groups for communication and video sharing? – As an institution, we cannot promote WhatsApp groups due to privacy issues. Sharing of video link of different classes, subjects and number of videos are not easy.

Will the videos be available for later reference? – Videos of the covered portions will be available till 31-03-2021. If the competent authority extends the academic year, availability of the videos also will be extended.

Can we have live classes using apps like zoom, teams, meet, ... instead of recorded classes? – Residential locations of some of the teachers and many of the students are having poor internet connectivity. Poor internet connectivity will result in user (teacher/student) going out of the class during the session. You will experience the same when you come in live session. If we adapt live classes, then chances are high that many students may find themselves difficult to be in live classes without breaking the connectivity. We experienced this problem when we had a trial in the month of March with the students of Std 12.

You are requested to pay special attention to the following during Google Meet

- Students must be in decent dress. There is no rules like student should be in uniform.
- Other members of the house please be aware that the camera is on in the device your ward is using. Therefore, please avoid any other activities in the room as far as possible. Parents please pay special attention not to happen the following and the like changing dress in the same room, using washroom, attending the google meet with eatable items ...
- If students should be have respective subject textbook, notes and any other material that the subject teacher ask for with them when they come for google meet.
