- Midterm test for classes 04 to 07 will be out of 40 and its duration is one and half hours. Internal marks will be out of 10 (5 marks for notebooks and 5 marks for test papers/oral test). Total will be out 50 (40 + 10).
- Midterm test for class 08 will be out 80 and its duration is three hours.
- Periodic Test 2 for classes 09 and 10 will be out of 80 and its duration is three hours.
- Classes 08 to 10 will have 20 marks internal (5 marks for oral test, 5 marks for Subject Enrichment, 5 marks Portfolio and 5 marks for notebooks). Thus total would be 100 (80 + 20). If any of the assessments is not conducted, then the best marks out of the other internal marks will be considered to replace the not-conducted internal components.
