

## **Annual Examination – Class 11**

Annual Examination of Class 11 commences on 26-Feb-2021.

Mode of writing examination (from home or at school) can be decided by the parent. Kendriya Vidyalayas and Navy Schools have already decided for writing examination at school. Rules of writing examination from home and at school are given and it will be strictly followed.

### **General Rules of Examination and Promotion:**

1. Any malpractice while writing examination will be taken seriously.
2. As per CBSE examination bye-laws, senior secondary students (Class 11 & 12) must score at least 33% of marks separately for theory and practical/internal for promotion/higher studies. Since there were no practical held this year due to the pandemic, there will not be practical examination. Instead of practical examination, marks of the midterm examination will be considered proportionately and the same will be followed for internal marks for non-practical subjects.
3. As per the examination bye-law, if a student fails to score less than 33% in one and only subject, he/she will be given a second chance to write the examination. But, considering the special situation rising out of the pandemic, students will be given more than once chance to clear the examination.
4. Writing examination beyond second chance will have an examination fee of Rs 200/- per subject per examination either from home or at school. Examinations will be held on continuous days without gap from second chance.
5. Parents/students have to register for examinations in which mode of examination is to be marked. Google Form will be given for the same. A copy of the filled google form will be automatically sent to the logged in mail id by google itself and it should not be deleted until the completion of the examination. If any dispute on the mode of examination arises, then the mail will be considered as the sole proof of filling the google form.

### **Rules to be followed to write examination at school:**

1. Students must carry two copies Consent Letter of their parent on the first day. One copy must be submitted at school and the other copy will be given back to the student with school seal. Sealed copy of the Consent Letter must be carried by the student for all examinations. Format of the Consent Letter is available in Notice Board of the School Digital.
2. The then prevailing protocol of Covid 19 should be strictly followed.
3. Students must follow the instructions of the teachers/helpers/security at the school gate and entrance.

4. Students can use bicycles to reach school.
5. If necessary, parents can send a basic mobile handset (without camera) with the student. Such students must carry a letter from the parents addressing the principal, stating the reason for carrying the mobile. Students must switch off the mobile when they enter into the school campus.
6. Students must disperse from the school ground immediately after the examination and should not gather.

**Rules to be followed to write examination from home:**

1. It is the duty of the parent/student to make sure of an internet connection which will not fail throughout the examination.
2. Question paper will be mailed to the official mail id of the students who have registered for online examination before 5 minutes of the schedule. Students must check in inbox and spam for the mail. Responsibility of the school is limited to sending the mail on time.
3. Students who are writing examination online will be divided into a set of 4/6/8 students and each set will be given separate google meet link. One teacher will be assigned to watch a set of students writing the exam and the same will be recorded.
4. The google meet link will be mailed to the official mail id before 30 minutes of the schedule. All students are expected to enter the google meet at least before 15 minutes of the schedule.
5. Students must come in the google meet with video and audio. Video must be in such a way that teacher can see the student writing the examination fully. Device, used for google meet must be kept at a required distance in such a way that your video will look like the following:



6. Students must remain in google meet with video and audio until the answer sheets are uploaded to Google Classroom. Uploading time is 25 minutes. If a student uploads answer sheet after the given time, it will not be considered and such students will have to appear for the second chance.
7. If a student loses the connection in between the examination, the examination of the student will be cancelled and a second chance will be given after the examination. In the second chance, examinations will be held on continuous days

without gap with the same rules of the writing examination from home or at school.

Examination will be held out of 80 marks for non-practical subjects and out of 70 for practical subjects as per the latest CBSE pattern.

**Further Information:**

1. There will be a break of one week before beginning the portions of Class 12.
2. Result of the examination will be published latest by 17-Feb-2021.
3. There will be an open house for all students of Class 11 on 18, 19 and 20. Schedule of each student will be intimated by 15-Feb-2021.
4. Date of commencement of portions of Class 12 will be informed. Classes will start in online mode with google meet and classroom teaching is expected to begin from end of June 2021 or beginning of July 2021.
5. Online classes will be held in the month of April 2021 and students will be given a break when teachers go for paper valuation.
