A REPORT ON JOY OF GIVING 2022-23

The Joy of Giving is a charity programme at Sacred Heart CMI Public School conducted every year during Christmas season. A list of medical items and groceries is prepared in consultation with the Charity homes the students intend to visit. Students bring the items as per the list and these items are divided to be taken according to the number, gender and size of inmates at these institutions. The classes which completed the contribution first get the opportunity to visit the institutions and donate the items. Out of 59 classes, 24 classes completed the contribution in full strength.
