



Rotary International is an International Service Organization whose stated purpose is to bring together business and professional leaders in order to provide Humanitarian Service and to advance goodwill and peace around the world. It is a non-political and non-religious organization open to all people regardless of race, colour, creed, religion, gender, or political preference. There are 37,000+ member clubs worldwide, in which 1.4 million individuals, known as Rotarians, have joined.

Rotary Club of Cochin Lords is one among the 37000 + clubs. It meets once a week at IMA, Cochin. Cochin Lords caters to many services, especially those of the youth, like Shastra, Children's Science Congress, for Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools of Kerala, Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) for Senior School children, Gift of Sight Project, Lords Cloud Contest, Anti-Drug Projects for schools, Interact Club for Secondary and Senior Secondary students and Rotaract Club for students studying in different colleges in the city.

The Rotary Waves 2024 is another project instituted for Primary School and pre-school students of Cochin to discover and cultivate the Literary and Cultural talents of young children.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Rotary Waves 2024 will be held on 17th and 24th August, 2024.
- 2. Colouring with crayons, Drawing, Painting and Handwriting Competitions will be on 17.08.2024.
- 3. All participants have to report at the registration counter at Campion School on the day of the event at 8.00am.
- 4. A student can participate in 6 individual items.
- 5. If time limit exceeds, marks will be deducted.
- 6. The decision of the judging panel will be final.
- 7. Participants should not appear in their school uniform.
- 8. Pen drives / CDs are allowed for the dance item. It must be brought by the students and should be in good condition.
- 9. Destruction of school property will lead to disqualification. Campion Campus is plastic free. Hence avoid the use of plastics.
- 10. If participants do not report on time to the venue, they will be disqualified.
- 11. For English paragraph reading, content will be provided at the venue.
- 12. Participants will be solely responsible for their belongings.
- 13. Last date for registration is Tuesday, 12th August, 2024.
- 14. Canteen facility is available.

CRITERIA

Picture for colouring and paper for drawing will be provided at the venue.

2 minutes on stage and 2 minutes for arrangements for Fancy Dress.

Paragraph Reading – 3 minutes for Reading, 5 mints for preparations. Matter will be given at the venue.

Single Dance – Film Songs are allowed.

Competitions are common for boys and girls, except Rotary Prince and Princess.

Rotary Prince & Princess criteria:- Smartness, Presentation, Intelligence, Costume and Dressing (Background music may be used).

Best Baby Contest criteria:-Smartness & Dressing. Age limit for best baby contest is restiricted to 2 to 3^{1/2} years.

NB: 1. All participants should bear travelling and other expenses on their own.

- Contestant should report half an hour before each event and collect their chest numbers.
- 3. Decision of the judges shall be final.
- 4. Prize distribution will be on 24.08.2024 at 2.00pm
